Dick Benedetti's police and traffic report, 12/09/13:

I will not be able to make it but there is not a lot to discuss on the traffic and police front. I don't have anything new from Chief Johnson or Doug Treat, except that we have been getting extra patrols the last couple weeks with some concentration near Starbucks and on Quarry. I will be meeting both right after Christmas. Chief Johnson is on vacation this week.

I am attaching a recap that you all know I worked on from your comments, from goal 12 (Transportation) from our neighborhood plan and from a recap Jeff Novak helped put together in 2010. This recap gives both general and specific traffic goals.

It would be appreciated if we could discuss these items at the first couple meetings in 2014, so we written goals for me to go after in this next year. Thanks and have great holidays. Dick

Traffic Goals for Waluga Neighborhood

General

1. Keep cut through traffic to a minimum. One focus is new developments or traffic changes. Have new developments contribute to the costs of traffic management.
2. Request as much police enforcement as they can provide so traffic laws are followed and streets are safe.
3. Maintain current street classifications.
4. Ensure there is adequate parking as so not to impact vehicle traffic.
5. Improve landscaping with the possible addition of medians or side landscapes to retain a residential appearance and slow traffic.
6. Update neighborhood when construction may impact traffic.

Specific

7. Have traffic engineering see what can be done to improve traffic flow on Oakridge and Douglas.
8. Request more police patrol for stop sign abuse, with some specific emphasis on Oakridge/Quarry/Waluga Drive.
9. Request completion of landscaping on Quarry/Galewood and Quarry/Douglas intersections to replace white poles.
10. Request a higher barrier on south side of Douglas to better protect pedestrians.
11. Ask for more enforcement to stop left hand turns from Quarry to Boones Ferry.
12. Request no left turn from Douglas to Boones Ferry.
13. Request sidewalk/pathway/bike path on east side of Quarry.
14. Remove flashing yellow light from Quarry.
15. Have crosswalks painted on all sides of Oakridge/Quarry intersection.
