#### I. WNA Police and Traffic Action Plans

- A. Police Chief Jorgensen has extended his resignation date to the end of August Dick
- B. Traffic Action Plan follow-up reports
  - 1. Bus barn relocation Rett said the next step is for school district to file a Land Use Permit (request a variance to allow for a transportation depot on the Lakeview Blvd. property).
  - 2. Cars queuing on Douglas Way Cindy the last meeting was in June. Next to be tentatively in August.
  - 3. Overflow parking in commercial areas Cheryl more of a problem on the weekends at the Mercantile Dr. property.
- C. Safe routes to school Cindy Survey was finished in mid-July. Next neighborhood meeting is August 8, 6-7 pm, Lake Grove Elem. School library to learn about alternatives.

### **II.** Land Use Updates – Cheryl

- A. Quarry Commons working on framing of 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. Utilities will be installed on Quarry in next month; Kruse Oaks IV apartments installation of garage walls and underground utilities; Oakridge Rd 8 townhouses. Site plan sent to City; Parking study of 3970 Mercantile Drive/Elephants Deli, etc. has been completed.
- B. CenterCal developing property at Olson Clinic site on Boones Ferry. Will have underground parking and 3 floors above, up to 45'tall of condos/apts and retail.
- C. Habitat for Humanity subdivision proposal at BFR and Upper Drive for 23 attached townhomes. Neighborhood meeting scheduled for July 25 at LG Presbyterian church on Sunset Dr. and Reese Rd.
- D. City sold land on BFR/Sunset to Metro for 50+ low-income housing/work force housing.
