III. **School District News** – Cindy. The School Board has submitted an application to the City re: new Bus Barn location which was incomplete. They will resubmit and when deemed complete, a public hearing will be scheduled with the Development Review Commission (DRC).

IV. **Land Use News** – Cheryl.

A. Apartments behind Banner Bank – there will be 3 cuts in Quarry Rd. for utilities which could disrupt street access into January.

B. Cheryl attended a pre-ap for United Cleaners on Boones Ferry Rd – they want to change their façade.

### **V. Committees, Projects and Events**

A. LGBA – Bruce attended their November meeting. They will now be part of the Chamber of Commerce instead of being the Lake Grove Business Association. Lake Forest NA was there to lobby for their pathway plan.

B. Emergency Preparedness – Cheryl said the emergency boxes are in place and training will begin on using the contents.
