I. Traffic – Dick met with Fire Chief Don Johnson who said they are hiring and will now be fully staffed.

II. Traffic Goals and Action Plans – Dick

A. Slight rewording was acceptable to all.

B. #5 – Will Farley said there is not enough pedestrian traffic to warrant a crosswalk at Quarry and Galewood. Dick will talk to him to see if there are any plans to do a sidewalk on Galewood, and if not, to remove the yellow ADA ramp on Quarry.

D. #7 is temporarily suspended.

All were in agreement of above changes.

E. We discussed ideas to replace the ugly white poles (delineator poles) at Galewood/Quarry intersection.

III. School District news – Cindy

A. DRC Bus Barn relocation hearing on Jan. 4<sup>th</sup> was continued until Jan. 18<sup>th</sup>. You can watch on YouTube or Zoom. We are encouraging neighbors to write letters to the DRC in support of moving it.

B. School drop off & pick up – Cindy reported the School District is considering putting a crosswalk across Douglas Way, location TBD. She talked with Jennie Knapp, principal, re: drop-off and pick-up about the possibility of the busses not staying at the school once students are dropped off. This would allow cars to exit down that road directly onto Boones Ferry Rd. She plans to follow-up on this as Jennie is discussing this with the school police liaison Bryan Sheldon.

IV. Land Use News – Cheryl

A. Quarry Commons – they are working inside the buildings for the next month.

B. Quarry West Condos – continues to be under major renovation for next 5 months.

C. The former Chevy's on Bangy Rd. may become a Chick-fil-a with a drive thru - Bruce.
